Are You Properly Insured?

All members of CRPO are required to carry appropriate [professional liability insurance](#) (PLI). CRPO is now conducting random audits of members' PLI. Members with inadequate insurance may face suspension, so be sure to verify yours.



Controlled Act Update

The 60-day [consultation window](#) on the regulation for the controlled act of psychotherapy is closing this Friday, June 15. Thank you to all members and stakeholders who contributed thoughtful perspectives on the regulation.

You will recall that, at the end of 2017, the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care gave CRPO until July 1 to develop the regulation, along with policies and supporting resources that delineate what is *not* included in the controlled act of psychotherapy. CRPO's Controlled Act Task Group, comprised of five Council members, will be bringing this work to a close over the next two weeks. Policies and documents will be shared as they are finalized.

Email vs CRPO Member Account Messages



Late fees. Conduct issues. Suspensions. These are confidential matters between a member and CRPO. When the issue is confidential, we message you via your member account in order to maintain your privacy.

Public consultations, practice advisories, renewal notices—these are the issues that affect *all* members, so we use email to bring these matters to members' attention.

Email is an effective form of communication, but it's not the most secure. Because maintaining confidentiality is of paramount importance to CRPO, we use member user accounts to communicate with you when your privacy is at stake.
